Overall Hi-Point to participate at all 3 shows with same horse/rider combination; Gaited Horse will be one buckle to highest points combined. In case of a tie, Showmanship placing will break it. **High Point Buckle to 39 & Over. You must declare in advance which age you are going for. The classes will run simultaneously with 19 & Over.**
