Three scholarships of \$1,000 and one additional, dependent on donations received, will be awarded to high school graduating seniors and/or students in their undergraduate college program based on:

- ◇ 30% academic standing (grades) 15% leadership, awards, & achievements
- ◇ 30% involvement with horses and horse projects 15% educational/future goals and plans
- ◇ 10% recommendations

To be eligible for scholarship funds, recipients must be a member of the CCEHC, CCSC, CCFMP and/or a member of an associated club of the council. Ask your club leader if your club is a member. This Scholarship can be used for college, trade school, or a special program. The scholarship must be used within one (1) year after being awarded. The scholarships will be awarded during the Clark County Fair (2023) in the Horse Arena on Tuesday August 8th at about 10:30 am after showmanship. A student can receive the Scholarship Award **twice**. Once a student has received a Scholarship Award twice, they are ineligible to apply.

Applications must be postmarked no later than June 15, 2023

To be complete, your application must include **ALL** of the following:

- ◇ This application form (Please type or print clearly)
- ◇ A current academic transcript from the last three years. The transcript can be an unofficial transcript, **BUT** the transcript **MUST** come from the school (on school letterhead, school stamp, school envelop, etc.). **Transcripts printed directly from online will not be accepted.**
- ◇ Three (3) recommendation letters from references who can speak to your academic ability, scholarship background, personal qualities, etc., but no more than two (2) may be from the academic community and **NONE** shall be from relatives, either by blood or marriage. The recommendations do NOT need to be on the attached "Reference letter" sheets. Recommendation letters may be included in the applicant's packet but, letters must be signed by the person writing the letter, placed in a sealed envelope, addressed to the applicant, and must be from the current school year September 2022 – June 2023.
